A girl child is still seen as a liability in many communities and therefore the marriage is performed before the children attain adulthood. In rural India, where education and employment are still a far off dream, there are illegal practices that are still carried on, hidden behind the veil of culture and tradition. *Child Marriage* is one such illegal practice still rampant in rural parts of India, where the girl child is still seen as a liability and therefore the urgency for marriage. *Children that are forcibly married before they attain legally permissible age of 21(male) and 18(female) have legal rights through which they can seek recourse in the Court of Law. Child Marriage is punishable under Indian Penal Code. It is a cognizable and non-bailable offence.*

Mr. Umesh Trivedi, Senior Advocate, MP High Court, has devoted his 45 years of experience in serving justice to people of MP, and now, through the online channels by imparting his knowledge for CHHAYAnke's noble cause. Each Youtube Video is a masterclass in itself, giving the necessary information and direction to people where justice is being delayed.
