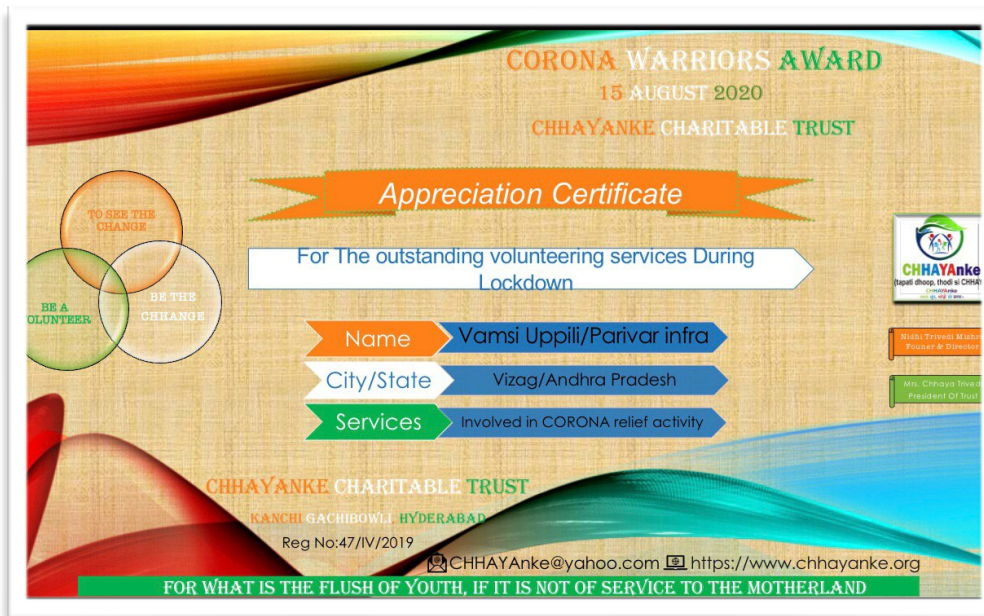

They learn time, distance and motion every single day travelling miles to fetch water into their hamlets. This critical thinking needs to be sharpened with elements of S.T.E.M education, which can transform them into extraordinary innovators.
